

XI'AN — To match its multibillion-yuan investment in developing Midwest Inland Port Financial Town – the largest metal-trading platform in Asia to date – Maike Metals Group needed a sizable gesture. The international bid for the project in Xi'an, China, was awarded to Shenzen-based Hallucinate, whose design transforms data into a graphic spatial element.

The designers incorporated digital walls – a modern-day play on ticker tape – to 'blur the boundaries between reality and imagination, modern technology and architecture. Clad in lengths of customized extruded aluminium, the walls ticker-tape structure. The designers say incorporate LED displays. A translucent coating softens the effect, making the displays more appealing to the eye. The

panelled structure also helps to absorb sound in the large, open lobby.

Rather than let the exterior determine they adopted this approach as it allows for undisrupted views from floor to ceiling. — TI hallucinate.com.cn
